

Enrichment

We are looking forward to continuing our Enrichment Program for our middle school students grades 5-8. In our enrichment program, students will meet monthly with an instructor/facilitator to complete activities based on student interest. At the beginning of each semester, students will select from one of several options available. For the semester, students will remain committed to their selection. On early release days, students will attend their group, which will consist of fifth through eighth graders. Group sizes will be limited and enrichment time will run for approximately one hour. We believe this is a great opportunity for students to explore new areas of study, further develop present skills and interests, and connect with loving adults who model Christ in their hobbies and careers. To achieve our goal, we need loving adults of all ages that are passionate about their hobbies and want to pass on their knowledge to a younger generation. The dates for the first semester are Wednesday August 29, Wednesday September 26, Tuesday October 9, and Wednesday November 28.
