Mission Statement: Providing a foundation of quality Christian Education upon which to prepare children for Godly leadership.

Language Arts	Middle school Language Arts classes focus on a wide variety of reading experiences to build Reading Strategies. Students use novels and other literary works including authentic nonfiction texts to work on fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension skills. Pre-Ap Classes are offered in 7th and 8th grade and include more advanced writing and citing.	
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Social Studies	Students in 6th and 7th Grades study World Geography. In 6th grade, the focus is on basic Geography skills and the Western Hemisphere. In 7th grade, the focus is on the Eastern Hemisphere. Students in 8th grade study US History from Colonization to the Civil War. Students learn from reading, lectures, projects, and cooperative group activities.	
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Mathematics	Students in 6th, 7th, and 8th grade mathematics work at the level that is most appropriate for them. We offer optional accelerated placement allowing students to take Pre-Algebra and Algebra I. All students learn through a variety of methods including hands on learning, lecture, guided discovery, and cooperative groups.	
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Science	Teaching revolves around an interactive class setting. Conceptual and mathematical understanding of the courses are also stressed. Problem-solving skills, critical thinking situations, and activity/lab-based learning will be incorporated throughout the courses. 6th grade general sciences - Life, Earth, Physical, STEM 7th grade general sciences - Life, Earth, Physical, STEM 8th grade Physical Sciences - Geology, Chemistry, Physics, STEM	
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Religion	Religion in middle school focuses on the life of Christ, His miracles, teachings, death and resurrection. Joined with this are special studies and devotions on the habits of Christian leaders, the “art” of prayer, Christian conflict resolution, and an in-depth study of one book of the Gospel each year.
