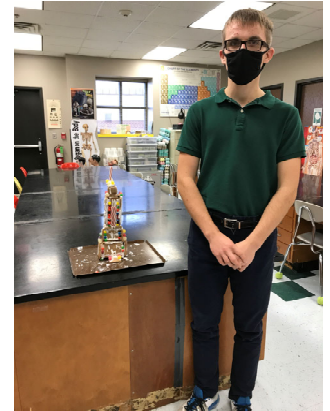


January 7, 2021

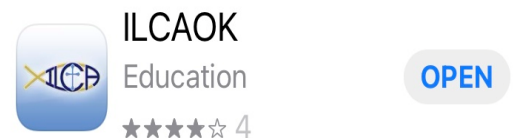
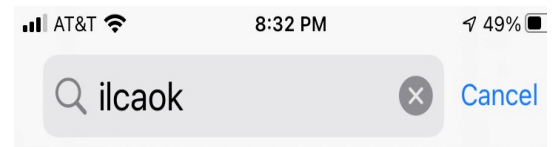
While all groups had great designs, the winners were Zach Brinkman and Kai Obrock. The award will stay in the classroom to inspire future 8th grade students.
