Spring Pictures - Order Deadline Sunday!

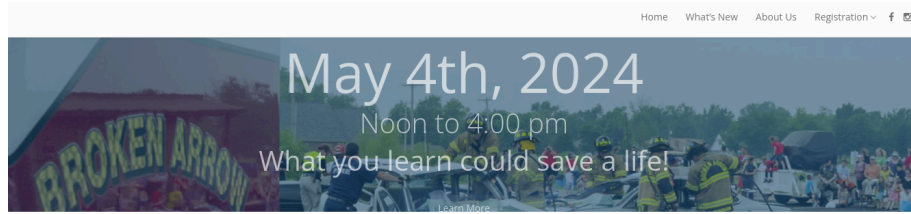
Your gallery is ready to be viewed. The Spring photos are available now. Orders are due Sunday, April 28. Orders should arrive by Friday, May 3.

NOTE: This will be the only round of orders with the end of the school year quickly approaching, so parents need to make sure to get their orders in this week.

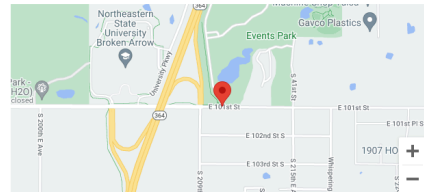

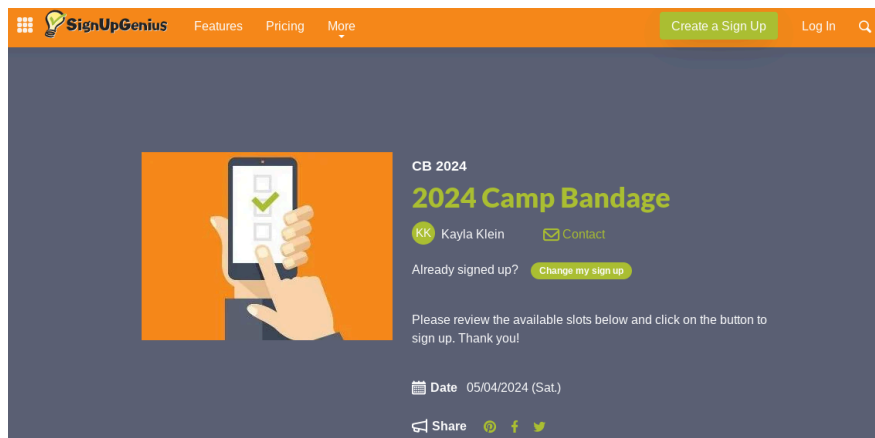
Anyone can Volunteer at Camp Bandage!

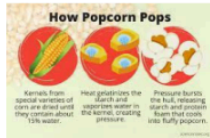
