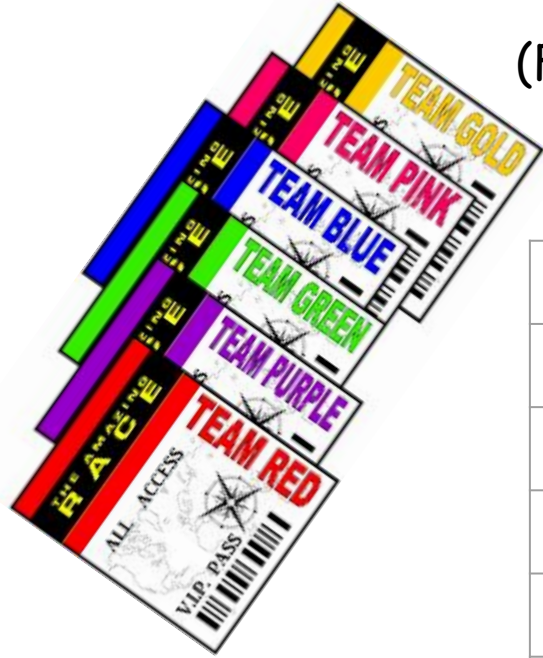

- Field Trips happen throughout the week. They include theme related activities off-campus, swimming at the city pool, playing at splash pads and area parks, and age-appropriate service projects.
- Occasionally, inclement weather will necessitate the cancellation of outside activities and/or trips. Our staff plans for these with fun indoor games, movie days, and other fun activities.
- Staff are First Aid and CPR certified.
- All activities are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances. Updates are sent out through Remind/Email when necessary and communicated via email weekly.

All campers will need to bring a backpack with the following **EVERY** day:

- Lunch
- Water bottle
- Sunscreen
- Books
- Towel
- Bathing suit
- Change of clothes

Cancellations must be received in writing at least 14 days prior to the start of the program week or you will be charged in full for the week. The cancellation policy is based on when we receive written notification. We do not prorate weeks for missed days (planned or unplanned) as we base space availability on enrollment.



ILCA Summer Camp Discipline Policy

We expect campers to act respectfully at all times when they are on ILC property or participating in ILCA sponsored programming. If a student is unable to change his or her behavior after being redirected by a staff member, the following will take place.

During Summer Camp, we will use a four point discipline policy to determine what action will be taken should a camper not follow the camp rules. These policies are put into place to ensure the safety of our campers as well as our staff.

Point One—This is the camper’s first written warning. This time the parent or guardian will be notified when the camper is picked up at the end of the day.

Point Two—This is the camper’s second written warning. The parent or guardian will be contacted immediately and informed of the situation.

Point Three—This is the camper’s third written warning. The parent or guardian will be contacted to pick up his or her camper immediately and the camper will be suspended from camp for the remainder of the day as well as the following day.

Point Four—This is the camper’s fourth written warning. The parent or guardian will be contacted to pick up his or her camper immediately and the child will be removed from the camp program, a meeting with administration will be scheduled, and camper may not be eligible to return.

In addition to our four point policy, there are also infractions that are grounds for immediate dismissal:

Any camper who runs away from the staff may be removed from the camp program for the remainder of the program. In the event that the staff cannot convince the child to return, the police may be called.

Any camper who harms themselves or another camper, this includes both physical and/or verbal abuse.

Any camper who assaults staff.

Any physical violence, foul language, or profanity will not be tolerated.

The Summer Camp Director reserves the right to dismiss a participant whose behavior endangers the safety of themselves or others.
