Opportunity Scholarship Fund Information


Applying for OSF is a two-step process at Immanuel. You will apply online at the OSF website. Then, you will need to log in to your FACTS account and select the “Grant and Aid” button to complete step two. Remember that this is an annual application process.  • Family of 5: \$203,019
 *For each additional family member, add \$28,859



How To Apply

1. Visit oklahoma.osf.org and click the "Apply Online" button or scan the QR code.
2. You will be redirected to an application portal where you will create an account.
3. Create an application for each student applying for a scholarship.
4. Locate a copy of your most recent 1040 tax form and proof of enrollment, such as an email, screenshot, scanned letter, etc.
5. If the student qualifies for a scholarship due to an EP, locate the current year's enrollment information and accommodations.
6. Upload documents to each application and submit.

Please note: students must not be accepted to a member school to receive a scholarship.

Scholarship Process

Member school evaluates financial need, confirms eligibility and recommends scholarship amount. OSF reviews the application and the recommended scholarship amount for compliance, sends family the award letter. Family clicks link in email to accept scholarship award.
